The proposed innovation is a monitoring and evaluation system managed by the target groups. It allows them to monitor and evaluate their own development activities in an independent, participatory manner. As tools, it uses simple and easy-to-use notebooks giving information on some significant indicators.

### 9. What problems does this innovation seek to solve?

- Poor capacities of target groups to monitor and evaluate their own activities

- In project evaluation, failure to incorporate target groups' assumption of responsibility for implementing rural development programmes

- Target groups' poor understanding of the roles of the various actors

### 12. Difficulties encountered

- Illiteracy
- The constraints of inaccessibility, which hamper supervision

## **13.** Costs and benefits of the innovation (financial, social, political etc.) *Costs:*

These are connected with the recruitment of a service provider to train and supervise facilitators for a year, and the holding of mini-workshops to evaluate the facilitators' activities. *Benefits:* 

- Greater involvement of target groups (women, men) in project activities
- Boosting of target groups' capacity for self-evaluation
- Improvement in village-level monitoring of development activities
